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# TRAINING NEEDS

1. Staff dealing with frail elderly people lack of skills related to the fundamental assumptions on which the work of the **occupational therapist** is based
2. Staff involved in training need to acquire the ability to read and transfer practices and information to the elderly's families
3. Need to increase and consolidate the European dimension within the activities of the organizations



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# PLANNED ACTIVITIES

Based on the training needs and areas of improvement identified the planned activities are:

- 4 **JOBSHADOWING** rounds in Sweden
- 2 **TRAINING COURSES** at the University of Seinajoki in Finland

In particular, activities foreseen during the jobshadowing:

- Detailed visit to the host welfare service
- Follow an occupational therapist daily
- Participate in activities as a team
- participate in recreational activities with local staff and guests of the host service
- Participate in training and information meetings addressed to families for the preparation and management of the personalized plan of activities



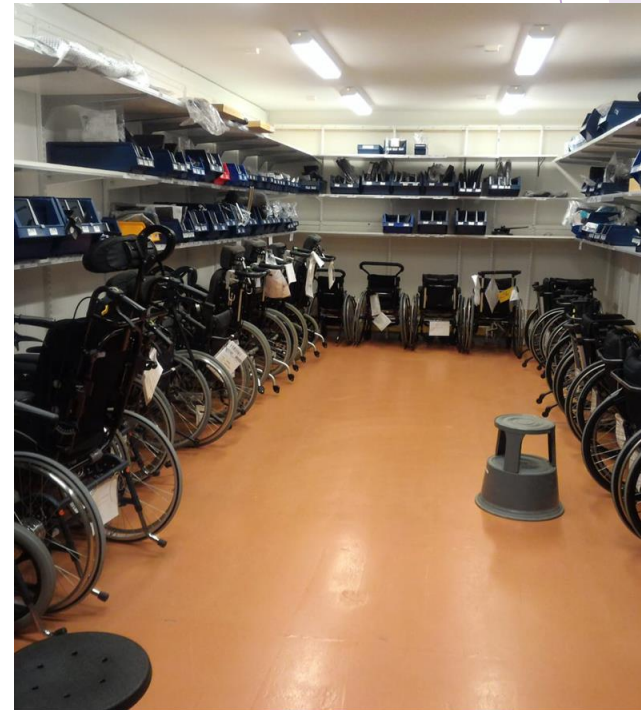
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# MOBILITIES
