# Seeking asylum in Sweden

*Swedish Alien's act* came into force 2006

- regulations and terms about asylum and residence permits
- temporary limitations from 2016 until July 2019

Application process

- Submit your application in application units at the Migration Agency
- Asylum seeker card
- Asylum investigation (interview) with a case officer at Migration Agency



# Rights for asylumseekers in Sweden

- Accomodation center
- Financial support
- Medical examination
- Medical care and dental care
- Working while waiting
- Learning about Sweden and the Swedish language



## Temporary residence permit

- 3 years permit with refugee status
- 13 months permit for a person eligible for subsidiary protection

## Permanent residence permit

- if you are self-supporting by employment or own business



# When you have been granted a residence permit

## Adults

- Introduction programme at the Employment Office
  - 2 years
  - Swedish language
  - civic orientation
  - other education if needed
  - internship for work experience

## Children

- Reception unit for newly arrived pupils
  - 8 week programme
  - mapping of background, interests and abilities
  - health interview
  - introduction to school subjects
