OBJECTIVES

The overall objective of Synergy Audit is to make an environmental audit training programme involving basic knowledge of EU and global regulations and directives and in-depth knowledge in environmental quality management, as well as in areas of certain importance for work on reducing the most negative environmental impact, e.g. energy efficiency.

Consequently, the building of effective and knowledgerich environmental audit education with wide dissemination across the EU for the support of public and private sector organisations in Europe, both for the contribution of an increase in environmental audits with in-depth know-how and for the prospect of organisations achieving environmental certification more easily with these audits.

IN PARTICULAR, THE SPECIFIC OBJECTIVES ARE:





Increase the number of environmental auditors across the EU at local, regional and national company level.





Developing a "train-the-trainer" methodology for people working in public and private organisations, which will further disseminate knowledge of environmental audits among civil servants, providing the necessary skills to implement audits for the public and private sectors.



Expand international cooperation between EU countries on environmental audits and at the internal national level between the public and private sectors and environmental organisations.
