



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Overview of the practice

"e-Protect" e-learning space: a one-stop-shop that provides instant access to digital learning resources.

Developed within the framework of the "e-Protect" project, co-funded by the Erasmus+ programme.

Overview of the practice

e-Protect Competency Scale for consumer and data protection skills for the elderly people:

- a useful tool for both elderly people and professionals working with them that provides a clear view of the necessary competences and training needs for internet safety
- a convenient way to measure older people's efficacy on these competences
- courses offered online and available for free for any user who registers on the e-learning space:
 - 1. Consumer behavior and protection
 - 2. Online payments and transactions
 - 3. Data protection and privacy



Overview of the practice

e-Protect Train-the-Trainer Toolkit:

- support adult trainers' capacity building on the implementation of the innovative training programme for the elderly
- provides knowledge and understanding of the curricula, instructions on how to prepare the training programme, instructional materials, and tips and advice on the eventual relationship of the adult trainer with the elder participants


There was a strong need and e-Protect specifically addressed it.

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Challenges

 a lot of elderly people are not open to learning new things as they have a more conservative way of thinking and/or they are reluctant to leave their comfort zone

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- difficult to put them in structured learning: ideally, they need someone to be next to them during their learning process and to personalise lessons targeted specifically to them (instead of being part of a larger group/in a classroom).
- there is also a fear/ignorance about the protection of their rights they need someone they can trust.

Transferability

- · the platform is open, free, accessible
- available in 4 languages (English, Greek, French, German)
- the material is mainly addressed to adult educators/professionals in adult education and can be used freely to organize and implement their own trainings, acting as such as multipliers





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
