Social policy in Cyprus is not officially recognized by the Central Sate as a competence of local authorities therefore we lack the necessary resources for facilitating the community. Given that, Nicosia Municipality benefits from the EU's Structural Funds, Asylum Migration & Integration funds, the EEA and Norway Grants, the Republic of Cyprus, and other funds, to develop a social and cultural infrastructure for the promotion of social inclusion and integration of immigrants to the local community and provide social services to vulnerable groups of population. 

- Many vacancies are in Greek
- Employers are afraid to hire migrants for legal reasons
- Employers are overwhelmed with job applications
- Access to information is limited, info is static
- Migrants do not know their rights!


